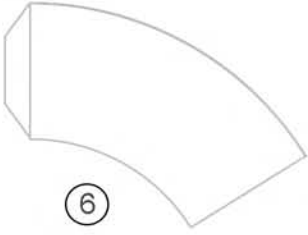
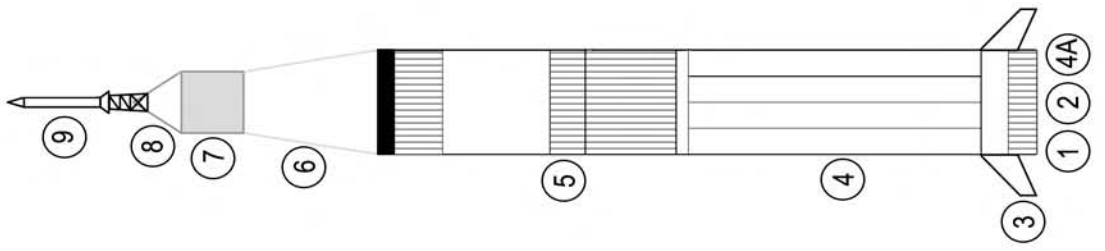
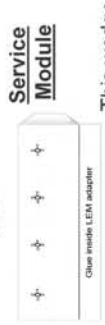


Saturn 1B SA-209 KSC Rocket Garden

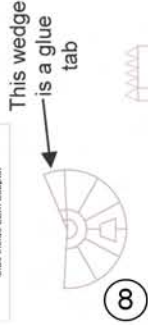

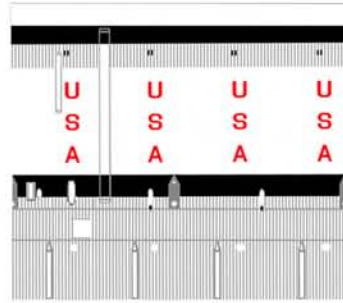

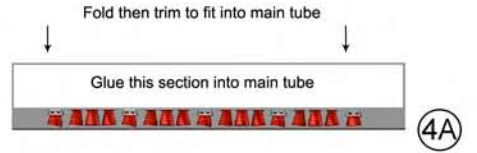

Roll Into Cylinder

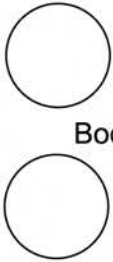

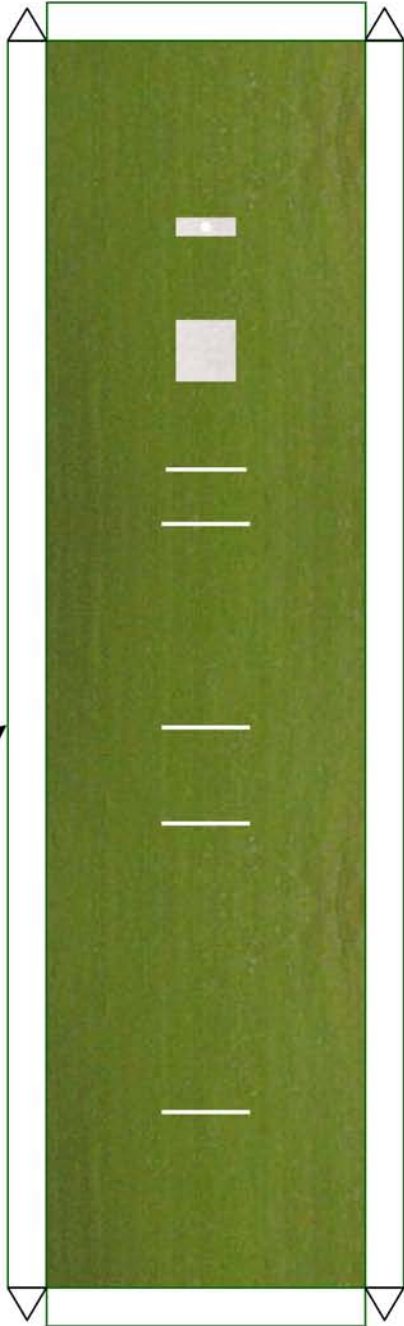




Fold back of wall along dotted line and glue

STRONGLY recommend stiffening underside of base with cardboard or thin piece of wood!

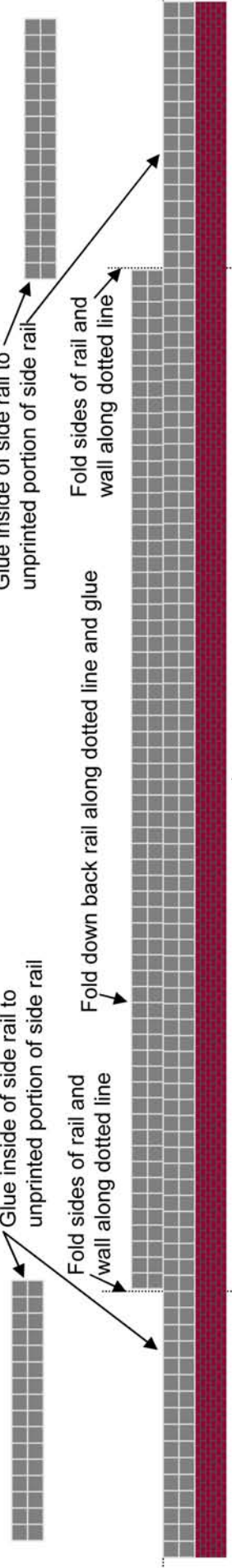
Glue inside of side rail to unprinted portion of side rail

Fold sides of rail and wall along dotted line

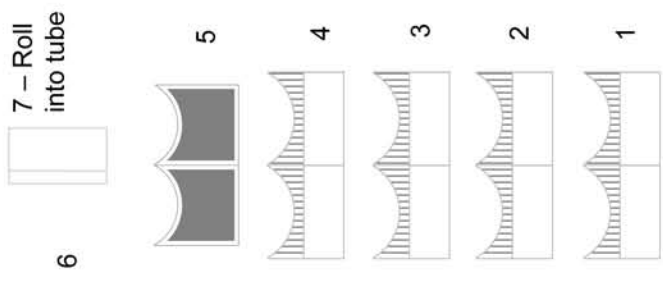
Fold down back rail along dotted line and glue
